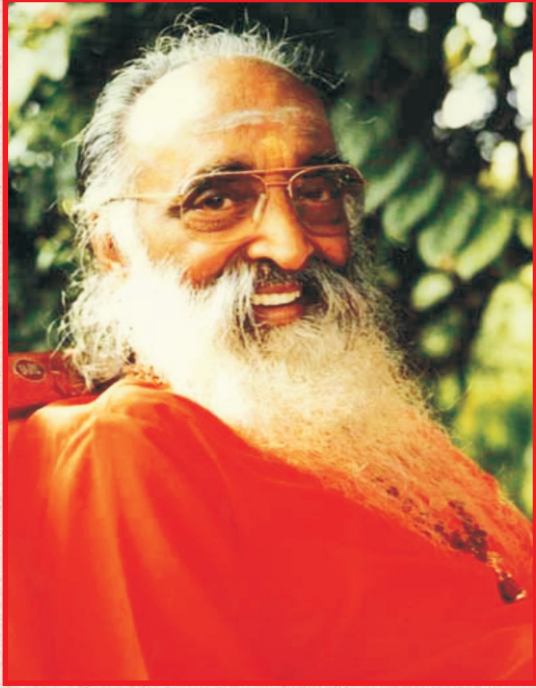

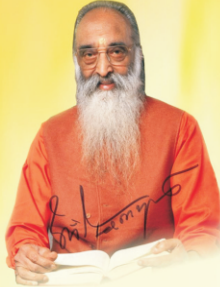

## **COMPUTER LAB -THE RANGE**

Computer skills are becoming an integral part of any profession. Apart from basic skills, advanced knowledge about the use of various computer softwares is given. A large number of students participate in Cyber Olympiad, Informatics Olympiad, Web designing and creativity Olympiad. **We have 230 computers with licensed operating system installed and connected to a dedicated server on LAN. Our school website is hosted on a virtual private server.**

## **LANGUAGE LAB AND SOCIAL SCIENCE LAB**

The school has a magnificent language laboratory to facilitate and optimize the language learning process of the students and a Social Science Lab to add another fervour to the learning experience of the students.

### **SMART CLASSES-The Techno craft**

In this ever widening and evolving era of technology, it is very important to upgrade the system and techniques of education. To enhance the teaching-learning process, the Vidyalaya has installed smart learning software in most of the classes. This has enabled our students to keep in touch with latest updates of modern education.

### **LABORATORIES - THE REACH**

Ample opportunities for the modern day methodology of hands on practicals "Learning by doing" are given. Children develop understanding of the concept, thinking and analytical skills; they experiment on a range of scientific equipments through the Maths laboratory and Science learning centres.

### **COMMUNITY LIVING, CAMP & EXCURSION**

The school aims at fostering qualities such as collective work, cooperative living, fellow feeling, appreciation for rural culture etc. The school organises various activities to bring about a unique dimension in the personality of the students.

### **EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES (THE SPIRIT)**

Student clubs help to identify, nurture and highlight the extra curricular talents such as music, dance, debating, elocution, sports, dramatics, art etc.

These are nurtured in a systematic way and self esteem is bolstered up by participating in such competitive events-both within and outside the school.

## **STUDENT COUNCIL - LEADERS OF TOMORROW**

Freedom and responsibility have to be learnt slowly and freely accepted in an atmosphere in which students exercise judgement and make free choices about matters appropriate to their age and level of understanding.

### **SWARANJALI (TRIBUTE WITH SWARA/VOICE)**

Conceptualised by Param Poojya Guruji Swami Tejomayanandji, it is a unique group of students, teachers and parents. The singers/performers present bhajans, patriotic songs and folk tunes or regional songs with lofty themes.

### **HOUSE SYSTEM**

In order to promote a competitive and healthy team-spirit in sports and allied activities, the whole school is divided into 4 houses — **Prithvi** (Green), **Agni** (Red), **Jal** (Blue), **Vayu** (Yellow). Based on all the activities of the school, including academics, the House accrues points in proportion to the performance of its members. The winner house is declared at the end of the session.

### **UNCHI UDAAN**

It is an extended learning programme for the students of classes XI and XII to improve their rank in competitive examinations like JEE Mains / Advance and NEET during school hours without giving extra burden to them.

### **WISH BOX**

Constructive suggestions are invited from students and parents. They can write their suggestions on a piece of paper and put them in the box. The box is opened at regular intervals and good suggestions are taken into consideration and implemented.

## **OPEN HOUSE FOR STUDENTS**

Student Council along with the Principal has an open house for students every week where students are allowed to voice their opinions and concerns. They are free to suggest for the development of the institution.

## **OPEN DAY FOR PARENTS**

Parents can meet the Principal and other senior staff members in an open house, where the parents can freely express their opinions regarding all school issues. School Management takes confidential feedback from parents which is used for improvement in the performance of the school. All feasible suggestions are acknowledged / recognised.

## **GRAND-PARENTS GALAXY**

Senior Citizen (above 60 years) can register themselves with us. They can participate and contribute with their experience towards the growth of the school. They are provided a special seat in all the functions next to the VIP galaxy. They can use the bus facility of the school for the same.

## **SCHOLARSHIPS**

A number of Merit-Cum Means Scholarships are given every year to the students belonging to economically weaker section of the society.

## **MEDALS & CERTIFICATES**

Top three rankers in each section (Pre Nur - Std. 2) and top three rankers in each class (Std. 3-11) are awarded medals and certificates every year during the Annual Prize distribution ceremony.

The students are also awarded with certificates for co-curricular and extra curricular activities.

A certificate is also awarded for 100% attendance for the entire session.

5. **Activities Gallery** : This section displays images of the latest events organized in the Vidyalaya. On clicking the images, users can view detailed information about the respective events.
6. **CVP Gallery** : This section showcases events conducted under the CVP (Chinmaya Vision Programme).

**Important Applications for Students :**

To access the following modules, the user (student/parent) is required to submit their login credentials and gain access:

- **Physical Activity** : In this section, students can enter details of their activities both inside and outside the school.
- **Yellow Page** : Under this module, users can view and update information related to themselves, their parents or guardians, and transport details after completing all required information during the first access.
- **Health Card** : In this section, students are required to enter their health records such as vaccination details, allergies (if any), medications (if any), and any type of illness, so that the school can take proper care of the child during school hours.
- **Std-X Feedback** : Students of Std. X need to fill out this form before receiving the Class X Board admit card.

- **Feedback** : Users can provide their valuable feedback for the betterment of the Vidyalaya.
- **Student's Feedback** : All students who are currently studying here need to fill out this form before every PTM.
- **Syllabus** : Under this module, an authenticated user is able to see topics under each chapter of each subject in a tabular format sorted in an academic weekly manner. This module also provides the user options to export the syllabus in PDF or XLS format.
- **Caution Money** : Students who have passed out from the Vidyalaya or wish to leave the Vidyalaya after completing two years are required to fill out this form to receive a refund of the caution money.
- **Model Question & Holiday Assignments** : From this section, users can view and download class-wise model questions and holiday assignments.
- **Scholarship/Freeship** : Through this, users can apply online for Scholarship/Freeship.

- **Ward Profile** : Shows your personal and academic details like class, section, and contact information. Used to view or verify student-related information.
- **Digital Syllabus** : Provides the subject-wise syllabus for the academic year. Helps you understand what topics will be covered in each subject.
- **Circular/Notice** : Displays important announcements and updates from the school. Keeps you informed about events, holidays, and instructions.
- **LMS** : An online platform for accessing study materials, assignments, and videos.
- **Library** : Gives access to library records, issued books, and due dates. Helps you track and manage your library usage.
- **Exam System** : Shows exam schedules, marks, and results. Allows you to monitor your academic performance.

- **Fee Receipt** : Contains downloadable receipts of fees already paid. Useful for records and official purposes.
- **Pay School Fee** : Used to pay regular school fees online. Provides a quick and secure payment option.
- **Pay Miscellaneous Fee** - Allows payment for extra charges like trips, events, or activities. Keeps all additional payments organized in one place.
- **Fee Support Ticket** : Used to raise queries or issues related to fee payments. Helps you get support from the school finance team.
- **Camp Management** : Provides details about school camps or excursions. Used for registration, updates, and information related to camps.
- **Digital Locker** : Stores important academic documents online. Ensures safe and easy access anytime.

- **Olympiad Registration** : Used to register for various Olympiad examinations. Encourages participation in competitive learning events.
- **E-Diary** : Acts as a digital version of the school diary. Used for homework, remarks, and teacher communication.
- **Tuition Fee Certificate** : Provides an official certificate of tuition fees paid. Useful for reimbursement or income tax purposes.

## GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS AND STUDENTS

The school believes in discipline and firmness. Slackness, disobedience and disregard of rules will not be tolerated and any work or action likely to lower the image of the school is regarded as a breach of the school discipline.

- Parents must get a prior appointment for meeting Principal/ Administration or any authority/Incharge/Teacher/through website or school diary.
- Parents must carry their **original photo ID proof** along with them during their visit to the school. It must be shown to the security guard at the gate. It is mandatory for safety and security.
- School has discretion to restrict access/entry of any visitor in the school campus.
- The parents/guardians are earnestly requested to extend their full co-operation to the school authorities :
  - i) By advising their wards to follow the school rules strictly.
  - ii) By taking active interest in the progress of their wards.
  - iii) By contacting the Principal or class-teacher with prior appointment in case of their wards facing difficulties in their studies.
  - iv) By providing their wards with tiffins and discouraging them from having food from outside vendors.
  - v) By clearing all dues payable to the school within the stipulated time.
  - vi) By ensuring that their wards do not possess any contagious disease while attending the school.
  - vii) By ensuring that their wards do not loiter on the roads, near the school gate after school hours. This may cause mishaps.
  - viii) By creating a very congenial atmosphere at home to enable their wards to develop themselves mentally, morally and socially.
- The Guardians / Parents are **forbidden to bring or distribute cakes and savouries during their wards' birthdays or on any special occasions.**

- They are required to inform the school if there is any change in their addresses or contact numbers.
- **Children, when sick, should not be sent to school to attend classes. Such children will be allowed to appear in the test/exam with prior permission only.**
- Attention of parents is drawn to the fact that criticism of the teacher or school in the presence of their children should be scrupulously avoided because it causes the students to lose respect for their teachers with the consequent failure to learn from them. It further retards their progress.
- Parents are advised to grant pocket money very judiciously to the students.
- If there is any legitimate complaint, the communication may be made through **complaintscv@gmail.com**, or during PTMs or through suggestion and complaint box in a specific format.
- Any communication made by parents/guardians should be addressed to the Principal and sent to the class teachers through e-mail
- The report card is an important document and should be kept safely. If the report card is lost, a replacement will be made on payment of Rs. 100/- along with proper application.
- The name, admission number, class, section and house of the students should clearly be marked on their belongings.
- Parents are requested to co-operate with the school in its attempt to help their children's progress by paying attention to their regularity, punctuality and discipline and by taking interest in their homework. They should check the school diary everyday and note the homework and other instructions in the diary. In case of small children, the parents are advised to check the bags of their wards.

- Students must take care of the school property and a fine will be imposed if any damage is caused by them.
- It is not advisable to bring valuable items like expensive watches, fountain pens, transistor radios, tape recorders, calculators, mobile phones and jewellery to school. In case of any loss of valuables, the school authorities will try their best to trace these but shall not take any responsibility for the loss.
- The students should be recognized not only by their School Uniform but also by their good conduct and behaviour as students of Chinmaya Vidyalaya.
- Parents should sign the occasional reports/remarks which the Principal or teachers make in the calendar/diary.
- Parents are requested to see the website regarding holidays, test schedules, Model Test papers. Feedback for the same can be given using student corner on the website.
- Attendance in the morning assembly is compulsory. Students must maintain attitude of reverence and devotion during the prayer.
- Student must not remain in the class room after school hours. If found, the school authority will take disciplinary action against him/her.
- A pupil who is found to be irregular in his/her attendance without bonafide reasons or without any explanation from the guardian will face serious consequences and withdrawal notice may be issued.
- Students must carry their School Almanac everyday to the Vidyalaya.

- **Students are not allowed to bring smart watch, mobile phones, I-pods, electronic goods etc to the school. It is strictly prohibited and disciplinary action will be taken, if they are caught.**
- **Students are not allowed to carry crackers or explosives inside the campus. If found, they will be terminated from the school.**
- A fine will be imposed if a student is found using abusive language/objectionable words / slangs / damaging the school property.
- Students should come to school in neat and clean prescribed uniforms (properly stitched & ironed) polished shoes and trimmed nails. Nailpolish, Mehandi etc. is not allowed for girls.
- Boys must have their hair cut regularly and shave when required. Colouring of hair is not allowed. The hair must be decent and combed.
- Girls should make pony-tail or braids if they have long hair. Colouring of hair is not allowed.
- Students coming to school by bicycle should keep it locked at the cycle stand. Vidyalaya is not responsible for any loss or theft.
- No student is allowed to come to school by motorised vehicles. In case the rule is violated, strict actions will be taken and parents may be asked to withdraw their wards.
- While dropping wards at the school gate, parents/guardians are requested to check the school notice board/confirm from the gate keeper regarding any exigencies like excess rain, strike etc. that might lead to the school being closed for that particular day. The school authorities will not be responsible for any untoward circumstances arising from such emergency like situations.
- No student will be allowed to leave the school premises or go home during recess.
- Any student found violating these clauses, will be subjected to serious disciplinary action.

## LEAVE RULES

1. Every student must have atleast 80% attendance to appear in any of the semester examinations. Those who fail to fulfil this criterion for any terminal will be debarred from that terminal examination and marked zero for the same in the mark sheet. Request from the defaulters in this regard will not be entertained. 80% attendance criterion is applicable to each of the two semesters separately. Benefits of having more attendance for a particular semester will not be transferred to the other. However, a certificate for 100% attendance will be given on the basis of the total attendance in an academic year.
2. In case, a student remains absent for four consecutive days without permission after a long vacation or in the beginning of the session, his/her name will be struck off the school rolls. For rest of the session, absence for six consecutive days, without prior permission, will lead to the name of the student being struck off the rolls. Re-admission will be purely at the discretion of the Principal and that too with full admission fee. A fine will be charged for every unexplained absence of a student from the school.
3. Re-admission will be permitted after paying the full dues including re-admission fee if the vacancy still exists.
4. All students are expected to join the school on the notified date at the beginning of the school term. A fine of Rs. 50/- is imposed for absence on the reopening date unless the Principal is informed before the end of the term which officially ends after the flag assembly on the last day. Parents and guardians should appreciate that absence during a term is not in the interest of the students. They are asked not to apply for leave, if it can possibly be avoided. Leave may be granted to the students only on the following grounds.
  - a. In case of serious illness or death of a very near relative.
  - b. For the condolence visits, if the student is the only male member of the family and his presence is essential according to the custom.
  - c. To attend the marriage of his/her own brother, sister or brother/sister of either parent.

- d. To perform the 'Tika' ceremony of his sister, if he is the eldest brother in the family.
5. Leave of Absence must be recorded / mentioned in the School Almanac along with the signature of the Parent / Guardian.

### **RULES CONCERNING ABSENCE DURING ILLNESS**

1. Any absence must be entered briefly in record of absence pages given in the diary and signed by parents or guardians.
2. Parents are requested to send a leave application in the diary and mail, if the student has been absent.
3. A student suffering from any contagious or infectious disease is not allowed to attend school till he/she has fully recovered. On return to school, a medical certificate duly signed by a registered medical practitioner is to be submitted to the Class Teacher.
4. Quarantine Period recommended for-
  - a. Chicken Pox — 3 weeks.
  - b. Measles — 2 weeks
  - c. Mumps — 2 weeks
  - d. Conjunctivitis — 1 week
  - e. Typhoid — 3 weeks.
  - f. Jaundice (Hepatitis) — Depends on recovery.
  - g. Covid — 14 Days or more if prescribed by Doctor. Please ensure that you adhere to the quarantine strictly.

### **BUS RULES**

1. Bus fee will be charged for 12 Months.
2. The Bus Pass must be carried while availing the school bus and shown on demand of the Conductor/Monitor/ Incharge.
3. An unauthorized traveller, if caught, even for a day will be penalized, according to the decision of the Bus-Incharge/ Principal/Management.
4. Disobedience in the school bus will make the students ineligible to avail bus facility and face disciplinary action.
5. Damage to any bus property will be recovered from the parents of the concerned students.

6. Bus fare may be revised whenever the cost of petroleum products is increased or when there is a need felt by the Management.
7. A student availing bus facility in any month of the year, will have to pay the bus fee for all the twelve months of the year.
8. Provision and mode of bus facility is totally at the discretion of the school.

## **EXAMINATIONS AND PROMOTIONS**

The school has implemented the proposal of CBSE. There will be two semester examinations, one in September/October and the second in February/March. Continuous comprehensive evaluation is done and the results are intimated to the parents. Scholastic and co-scholastic performance are considered for promotion and negligence in any subject can be a cause for detention in the class.

Application indicating valid reason for absence from any examination must be submitted in advance to the Principal and get sanctioned. Absence on any ground is not condoned.

The result of the examination announced, is final and will not be reconsidered. Pupils absent from any examination will not be re-examined and will not get any marks in that subject.

Promotions will be based on the overall average performance of the year. The yearly record of work consists of the day-to-day written work, including composition, home-work and daily lessons and an average performance in scholastic area.

A student who uses unfair means and/or receives or gives assistance in any form during tests will be given zero in the subject and a warning letter. Repetition of the same will result in dismissal of the student. A student who repeats the same class twice will not be allowed to continue for the third year.

## LIBRARY RULES

1. All students of the school are members of the library.
2. A student can borrow only three books at a time for a period of four weeks.
3. Books will be issued to the students, during the library periods. No book will be issued or returned during the teaching hours.
4. Marking, underlining or writing on library books, periodicals, and newspapers is strictly forbidden.
5. Reference books and current periodicals will not be issued to the students. These can be seen only in the library.
6. If the books are not returned within the specified time it will be viewed seriously and a fine will be imposed as per rules. Rs. 5/- per volume per day will be charged.
7. The librarian may call for a book at any time, even if the normal period has not expired.
8. In case the book is misused, wrongly handled or lost the person concerned will have to replace the book or pay the current market price of the book.
9. After reading, please ensure that the books, periodicals and newspapers are kept back at their respective places.
10. The members should take good care of library furnishings and equipment.
11. Eating & drinking inside the library is prohibited.
12. A 'no dues certificate' by each student is to be obtained from the librarian while his/her transfer/withdrawal from the school.
13. Library is a "Silence Zone". Kindly adhere to it.

## RULES FOR SCHOOL FEE

1. School Fee is payable in advance for every two months **by 25<sup>th</sup> of the first month in every bi-monthly cycle. Last date for payment of fee for Feb.-March is 10<sup>th</sup> February.**
2. If the fee for the months in respect to any student is not paid in full by due date, a late fine of Rs. 50/- per month will be charged.

3. If the fee is in arrear for consecutive two bi-months, the student's name will be struck off from the rolls and reconsideration will be at the discretion of Principal after payment of all arrears.
4. Parents must keep the online reference number and date (after making payment of fee) and quote the same in the table provided in Almanac for ready reference.
5. Caution Money is payable in full only after settlement of all dues. A student has to study for **at least two consecutive years** to get the refund of caution money.
6. The school reserves the right to amend the fee structure as well as the procedure of fee payment at any time during the academic year without assigning any reason. It will be notified in advance through school website or circular.

### **MODE AND STEPS OF PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEE**

Chinmaya Vidyalaya is now completely digitalized. We accept all fees through online mode only. Any other mode of fee payment will not be entertained.

#### **Method :**

- A : Enter the URL '[erp.cvbokaro.in](http://erp.cvbokaro.in)'
- B : Login with Registration No in the username and password.
- C : Click on "Pay School Fee" Icon.
- D : On the next page, check the details and click on "Pay Now" button.
- E : Make the payment of school fee from any of the options available.

**Note :** Kindly don't initiate the double / repeat payment in case the transaction is failed and money is debited. In such cases, parents are requested to wait for 1 working day, else inform the class teacher / office. Similarly parents are advised not to initiate charge back request with the payment gateway in case of more than one payment. All such payments will be refunded / adjusted by school.

## **DISCIPLINE**

The development of an individual's character can only be achieved through discipline. Self-imposed discipline, punctuality, neatness in dress, appropriate behaviour, respect, consideration for others, and a cooperative spirit are expected from every student.

- Students who are not in proper uniform on school days will not be permitted to enter the school premises.
- The school logo, name, pictures, news items, photographs, videos, or any related information must not be used by students or parents without written permission from the school authorities. The school reserves the right to initiate legal action for any misuse of its name in addition to disciplinary measures.
- Students must adhere to the prescribed school timings. Any student arriving late will be sent back from the school gate, and the school shall not be held responsible for any consequences arising from the student's late arrival.
- Parents are requested to drop and pick up their children as per the timing mentioned in the Almanac/Diary or as per the notification. The school shall not be responsible for the safety and security of students outside the designated school timings.
- Students availing the school bus facility are required to maintain proper discipline and adhere to all transportation rules. Any act of indiscipline reported against a bus user shall invite disciplinary action, which may include suspension or cancellation of the bus facility for the remainder of the academic session.
- Parents/guardians applying for their ward's admission are deemed to have accepted this condition.

## **SOP FOR STUDENT INDISCIPLINE**

Purpose: To maintain a safe, disciplined, and respectful school environment through a fair and uniform disciplinary process.

### **1. Minor Indiscipline**

Examples : Talking back, class disturbance, incomplete work, late coming.

Action : Verbal warning, counselling by the Class Teacher/School Counsellor, and record maintenance.

### **2. Major Indiscipline**

Examples : Repeated disobedience, disrespect to staff, abusive language, property damage, bunking classes, stealing, etc.

Action : Written warning, parent meeting, written undertaking, and may be suspended for 1–7 days.

### **3. Gross Indiscipline**

Examples : Violence, bullying, threats, possession of prohibited items, substance abuse, serious cyber misconduct.

Action : Immediate removal from class WhatsApp Group, enquiry by the Discipline Committee, parent intimation, suspension for 7 days to 1 month, and recommendation for a Transfer Certificate (TC) if required.

### **Suspension Guidelines**

- No campus entry during the suspension period.
- Rejoining is permitted only after approval and submission of a written assurance.

### **Transfer Certificate (TC)**

- May be issued in cases of repeated gross indiscipline or when a student poses a threat to safety.
- Issued as per CBSE norms after due approval.

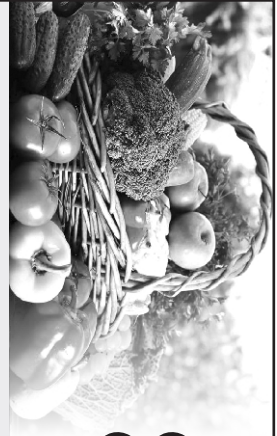
